


Luke 2:11 *"For unto you (Shepherds) is born this day in the city of David a Savior, which is Christ The Lord."*

I want to thank God for this testimony to Him and Him alone be the Glory. It started in July, I started to get a hunger for reading the Bible. I never really got the hunger to read all the Bible, so I started reading the Old Testament. (I hear it in church, but I wanted to know it for myself.) I would read for a while then get on my computer and play games. One night before going to sleep I felt something out of place. So, I prayed, "show me what is it Lord." That night I had a dream, I was witness watching someone going to hell. As they slid down the shaft — I could hear them screaming and pleading. I was taken back to the earth then the angel took me again to stand in the control room in hell, where I went down the same shaft, and slid to a room. Out of my own mouth the words of, "I should have dropped those games!" Instantly the dream was over, God reviled to me what was wrong (remember that's what I prayed for, well I got it).

All day the next day I was bothered or troubled by that dream. When evening came, I finally came to the decision to drop the games. (I can play games, just not 3 types- football, demonic, first-person shooters — the only one I really liked was the first-person shooter, all others I didn't play.) So, I started deleting those games off the pc when I got home, and not just those, any and every game that could be a distraction I got rid of. In the midst of deleting them I asked God, why is this so difficult? It's just a game, then He spoke, "IT'S NOT THE GAME SON, IT'S YOUR WILL."

All those years as a boy . . . 46 yrs I wanted to know Gods will . . . I felt all that time instantly came together in my mind, felt like Ezekiel's bone came together all at once! I about got floored, not once did I realize what I thought was a game was really no game at all spiritually. This was a stronghold of the enemy in my life. This was nothing more than a distraction I have had for 46 years. What was I being distracted from . . . Knowing God!

So, about a week went by, then one morning the Lord woke me up at 5am — I received a vision Here is the vision that I saw: Jesus sat at the middle of a table; He did not look happy just sat there. In front of Him on the table were all these fruit baskets in rows of three. Then a demonic creature came in and started taking the fruit baskets off the table. I asked in my mind, why is he taking those fruit baskets off the table, why are you letting him take them away? Jesus replied, "because he has claim to them." I said, "he has claim to them?" and Jesus said, "keep watching."

Just then the enemy tore open a fruit basket. I could see what looked like a shiny apple, but there was a rotten banana. At this point, Jesus spoke and said, "mixed fruit." Now I have found whenever God is showing you something, whether is be in a dream or vision, knowledge just comes to you, not everything has to be explained, you just know some things, without being spoken. I knew when He said, "mixed fruit" He was not saying there were different kinds of physical fruit, He was saying there are good and bad fruit in those fruit baskets. Then I got to see in front of Jesus, (I was not controlling the view points, but I have found that the Lord knows how to let or make you see.) At this point new fruit baskets starting coming on the table in rows of 3 — when Jesus saw this his countenance brighten up, and smile came over His face, then He said, "FRUIT FIT FOR A KING." The vision was over, in about a week the Lord spoke to me about the vision. He went over the vision with me again, then He asked me a question. He said, "how long have you been under the Ministry of Christ?" The best I could remember I said, "Lord, I think about 32 yrs." He then said this to me, "For 32 years you have produced mixed fruit, NOW you have passed from DEATH to LIFE."

So, what does death to life mean? More than I can write however so that you may get a glimpse (those of you who don't know) I have JOY when I should not have it according to the world, I have SELF-CONTROL — more than I ever could believe, and PEACE — all the time. There are two point I would like to make. For 32 yrs I have struggled to do good . . . not always but there is the mixed fruit, however with this new life (total surrender to HIM), one of the most amazing things is I produce fruit, without trying! You see I don't have to try; it just comes out. Then another most incredible difference is I have no fear of failure!!! I have NEVER had no fear of failure!! About games, I no longer play them, even though I can (God did not say I couldn't, just the types He told me not too) however I find them pointless! They do nothing but distract me from listening, following, hearing and interfering with the Spirit of God! I will keep my mind on Jesus and Heavenly things. I have been experiencing this progression I don't exactly know where it's going, but I will find out with Jesus, here is what mean: 1st-need Jesus; we ALL need Jesus but how many truly know that and practice it? 2nd-want Jesus; is Jesus actually desired around you all the time? 3rd-choose Jesus; I don't care if there are 1 million ways, I choose the path with and of Jesus. 4th-Love Jesus; Jesus said, "if you love me, you will obey my commandments." So, do you? 5th-Fear; The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom yea, I'm finally getting some wisdom. Now, none of this is nothing new, it was just my turn to understand it.

I must also thank ALL the prayers, from Jesus, to the overseers, ministers, only God knows how many and where they came from. Well, that's the testimony that the Lord thru his Love, Mercy, Longsuffering, Patience, Perseverance, and Grace that He continued to work with me even after 32 yrs of being under the Ministry of Christ and producing mixed fruit. NOW being transformed from death to life, Praise God!

LITCHIA (TISHA) MCINTYRE



In the Bible the phrase "Do not be afraid" is stated 365 times. That is one time for ever day of the year. Also in 2 Timothy 1: 7 it states, "For God hath not given us the spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind". I praise my Lord and Savior who delivers his people from fear. He has delivered me!

I have to share a back story on how this came about: Years ago when I was a child (probably around 4-5 years old), God delivered me from the spirit of fear. I was extremely afraid of the dark. I went to Pastor JoVah to ask for prayer. She shared with me that the Lord protects His children no matter where they are with angels just like how

the Lord had shown her the vision of the angels surrounding the Lord's house. Then the Lord had her to tell me I did not need to be afraid because I was protected by His Angels. From that moment, I never was afraid again. Over the years, the Lord has blessed me to not have a fear of things. I have an awareness of to be cautious of danger, and situations, but no fear because I know the Lord is there surrounding me with his angels to protect me.

In October 2021, I was diagnosed with cancer, prior to the diagnosis, the Lord gave me comforting dreams encouraging me that the situation was not determined, I went in for a what I thought was a routine check; was told I needed a biopsy. When the results came back positive, the Lord kept the fear away. I never saw the diagnosis as a death sentence, because the Lord had the situation in His hands and it was not determined yet how everything would be. The Lord saw me through the chemo treatments and surgeries. Many prayers from His overseers and people were prayed on my behalf; And He answered... in April of 2023 the doctors told me that I was done with treatments, and no cancer was left. I cannot tell you how grateful I am to the Lord for His mighty works.

After some time, I was still having some complications from the medicines, and chemo treatments. I was back at work, and doing the best I could to get back to a "happy normal". I started to have what seemed to be random panic attacks, and feelings of being overwhelmed. Some days I was perfectly fine, then I would be out somewhere and have to go immediately to a quiet place with no one around. Only way I can explain this is like symptoms of Claustrophobia. I felt boxed in. This went on and off for over a year, going on two. I prayed to the Lord about it, and came to the conclusion that this was a side effect from the treatment. If anyone knows me, God has blessed me to never have a problem in crowds of people. We have worked so many fairs and large crowded events over the years, and never had issues. In April of 2024 I found a bulge in my abdominal area. I went to the doctors, and after many appointments, doctors, and test, over one year later they found what the issue was. So that's the History.

Here is the breakthrough point:

The last test I had to take before my last surgery was another MRI. I have had many of these tests before in the past without any issues. But the last few times I had to go through two MRI's, and I experienced such a fear come over me that I almost couldn't get through them. And here I was again, ready to go through this test. I had called the Lord's house for prayer as I was leaving to go to the appointment. The preparations were done, and I was in the room. I laid down and was getting ready to go into the machine when I was struck with panic and fear. I had to get up and walk around. I ended up calling the Lord's house again for prayer. The overseers prayed with me and encouraged me, reminding me that God does not give us the spirit of fear. After the call I went back into the room. As I laid back down the Lord reminded me of when I was a child, and how I was delivered of fear. So I had to ask the Lord to forgive me because I let that fear overtake me. If you have ever had this kind of test, you know they put headphones on you and ask what kind of music you would like played. I requested a Christian artist named Steven Curtis Chapman. As the test started the first song began to play, "Be still and know that he is God." That made me start to scold myself. The Lord reminded me also in Psalms 42:5 where it states, "Why, my soul, are you downcast? Why so disturbed within me? Put your hope in God, for I will yet praise him, my Savior and my God." God blessed me to get through the test without a problem. And from that day, I have not had any anxiety or panic attacks.

I hope my testimony encourages whoever reads this that our Lord is Real. He can take care of any problems we may have. We have to believe and trust in Him.

The combination also has benefits for skin health, such as moisturizing and exfoliating properties.



MILK AND HONEY CAKE

Ingredients

2 1/4 cups all-purpose flour
2 teaspoons baking powder
1/2 teaspoon baking soda
1/4 teaspoon salt
3 eggs, at room temperature
1 cup buttermilk, shake carton
3/4 cup honey
1/2 teaspoon pure vanilla extract
12 tablespoons unsalted butter, at room temperature
3/4 cup granulated sugar

Directions to make the cake

- Preheat the oven to 350°F. Grease two 8 by 2-inch round pans with butter, line the bottom and sides of the pans with parchment paper, and grease the paper.
- Place a large sifter or a sieve in a large bowl. Add the flour, baking powder, baking soda, and salt and sift.
- In a small bowl, whisk the eggs together. Set aside.
- In another small bowl, whisk together the buttermilk, honey, and vanilla. Set aside.
- Using an electric mixer with beaters or a paddle attachment, beat the butter for 30 to 45 seconds on medium speed, then gradually add the sugar. When all the sugar has been added, stop and scrape down the sides of the bowl with a spatula. Continue beating on medium speed for another 4 minutes or until light in color and fluffy.
- With the mixer still on medium speed, add the eggs 1 tablespoon at a time, over 3 minutes. If the batter curdles, add 1 to 2 tablespoons of the flour to bind it back together.
- With the mixer on low speed, add the dry and wet ingredients alternately two times, starting and ending with the dry. Mix until just combined and smooth.
- Don't overbeat. Scrape down the sides and bottom of the bowl with a spatula to make sure it's well combined.
- Pour the batter into the prepared pans and smooth the top. Bake in the center of the oven on the same rack for 35 to 38 minutes or until a wooden skewer inserted in the center comes out clean, and the cake bounces back when lightly pressed. Remove the cakes from the oven and let them stand for 10 minutes. Run a butter knife around the cakes to gently release. Peel off the parchment paper from the sides. Invert the cakes, peel off the bottom piece of parchment, and cool on a wire rack.

Directions to make honey whipped cream

- Pour the cream into a cold large metal bowl. If adding any flavoring (yogurt and confectioners' sugar), add it now.
- Using a balloon whisk, whisk the cream until it has doubled in volume, has smooth soft peaks, and is light and fluffy. Add some finely grated zest for a delicious tang.



Ingredients-Honey Whipped Cream

2 tablespoons of honey
1/2 cup heavy cream, chilled
1 tablespoon of sifted confectioners' sugar

CLASSIC MILK AND HONEY DRINK

Ingredients

1 cup of milk (whole milk preferred for creaminess)
1 tbs honey to taste
Optional: a dash of cinnamon, vanilla extract or pinch of nutmeg

Directions

- Warm the milk in a small saucepan over medium heat, combine any optional spices except for vanilla extract.
- Heat gently, whisk occasionally until steam rises and small bubbles begin to form around the edges of the pan, but do not let it boil.
- Remove from heat, pour the warm milk into a mug and stir in honey and vanilla extract (if using) until the honey is completely dissolved
- Garnish with cinnamon or nutmeg if desired.





THE GREATEST PROPHECY

"In the beginning, in the Garden of Eden, Adam and Eve turned away from God's command. Their choice brought sorrow into the world, yet even in that moment of loss, God spoke a promise of hope a promise that one day, a Savior would come." Yes, it was a sad day, because sin entered the world but even then, God promised that: "One day, the child of a woman will crush the serpent's head." God's spoken promise spoke of hope that evil will be defeated forever.

As years passed, God kept reminding His people of His promise. He told Abraham, "Through your family, all the nations of the world will be blessed." In Genesis 15:5, the Lord took Abram outside and said: "Look up at the sky and count the stars if indeed you can count them. So shall your offspring be." and Abraham looked up at the stars so many he could not count them and he believed God's word.

God spoke to David, the shepherd boy who became king. He said, "Your throne will last forever." He promised David that from his family line would come a King whose throne would last forever; a prophecy pointing to Jesus Christ. David sang songs about a greater King, one who would rule with love and goodness.

God spoke through Isaiah many prophecies about Jesus about His birth, His life, His suffering, and His eternal kingdom. Isaiah 7:14 "The virgin will conceive and give birth to a Son, and will call Him Immanuel, means God with us. To us a Child is born, to us a Son is given... and His name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. The Angels filled the sky and sang of heaven's joy and the good news of His birth was shared with ordinary shepherds who came to see the great joy; God used these ordinary shepherds to show us that even ordinary people like us; we too can meet the Savior. Wise men as far as the east followed a star to worship Him, God shows us through these wise men; that even nations far away would come to worship Him. Jesus foretold birth remind us that Jesus is the Savior for everyone, rich and poor, near and far, young and old.

Before He went back to heaven, Jesus told His disciples, "Go into all the world and tell the good news." He promised that one day He would come again. The Bible says He will return with power and glory, and every eye will see Him. He will make all things new, no more tears, no more pain, no more death.

So we wait, just like God's people waited long ago. We wait with hope, because we know the Savior has already come, and He will come again. The promise from the garden has come true, and it will be finished when Jesus returns. His name is Jesus Christ, the Son of God, the Savior of the world.
