1 Chronicles 15:1, And David made him houses in the city of David, and prepared a place for the Ark of God, and pitched for it a tent. Notice in this scripture that the beloved son of God David, prepared a place for the Ark of God. The Ark of God is our Lord Jesus Christ. God prepared a place for Christ through the law and prophets, we see fulfillment of preparing the way through John the Baptist that voice crying, "prepare ye the way for the Lord" This made him the greatest of all the prophets ever born of woman. No matter how big the house, nor how great the city is, a place must be prepared for the Lord. The word also says, and pitched for it, meaning for the Ark a tent standing of the people.

2 Peter 1:13, I think it is right to refresh your memory as long as I live in the tent of this body, yes, we must pitch a tent for the Lord, that tent is our own body, and others we meet along life's way. Peter called his body the Tabernacle, meaning tent. Is your heart the place prepared for the Ark of God? Have you really pitched your tent there as a place to hold God and to carry God with you wherever you go? We are only Pilgrims passing through this mortal life that God has given us, and if we do not use this life for the Lord, we really are not fulfilling our purpose for God here. We are called for God's purpose; we are the salt of the earth.

Matthew 5:13, You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled underfoot. Christ alone is the grace and truth of our God, and you get down into the word Palatable and see this truth: PAL = Friend A = Alpha TABLE = Table of the Lord

Truly, we should always do the Table of the Lord service. If we have lost our saltiness, we are not useful to our Lord. We would be fit for nothing else but to be tossed out. "Father, let me have a purpose at your table, and be of service to You. A purpose that will help and heal all wounds and bruises that You received here in the flesh. All wounds Your Holy Spirit has suffered, and the hurts unto Your Devine Soul, forgetting my own hurts. My prayer is that You make me and mold me more and more into Your own image, Oh Holy of all Fathers Amen" Let this be our prayer, pick me up and use me Oh Lord, that I may be of profit to You. That I might Glorify Thee and Thy Name. That I might be Your friend as well as Your servant and Your Son Oh Father, the world will not understand that relationship, but You alone can grant it unto us, Amen"

I ask each of you today while you are making houses in this city of life, are you really, really, pitching your Tent here for Jesus? Did you prepare a place for Christ? Our purpose is to make this mortal life Palatable, and we can only do this by carrying God's Word within us and letting our conversation flow to the world. Sometimes you may be carried by God used in a way you know not at the time. It may even seem satan has had you for sure but God weaves the events of this life into His plan of Salvation and cleanses your soul and stamps you not guilty. This takes God, no man can do that for you and give you that peace but God himself by His own wisdom, knowledge, and understanding.

Our God alone is that God, The I AM of the Spirit, comes to us today through the blood and the fire of the cross. He is our burnt offering; He Jesus, is our great teacher here and now, and for always in these places of great peace and understanding and love that passes knowledge. we through Him receive the peace the world cannot give. Peter was at a great table when He feasted along with others on the event of the transfiguration. Peter was willing not only to pitch one tent but three on that day. One for the law, one for the prophet, and one for The Christ. We may be willing to do many things, but are you willing to do God's will alone? Peter did, he took up his cross and followed The Lord, can you afford to do less? Let us make sure we pitch out tent for Christ and Christ alone. Sprinkling it with the Blood of Jesus Christ.

DIARY LIGHTS

Pastoral Message Scripture Reference

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; 20 you were bought at a price. Therefore, honor God with your bodies.

Romans 12:1 Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God this is your true and proper worship.

Understanding this question

Is Your Tent Pitched For Christ?

My appreciation of this message is understanding it's metaphorical question, referring to how someone's life and values are aligned with their faith. It's not a literal question about a physical tent. When the Israelites would pitch their tents as they journeyed through the wilderness, caring the portable sanctuary; the Tabernacle, it was a central part of their lives, a reminder of God's provision as well as His presence.

Pitching a tent for Christ means that we should dedicate our lives to follow Christ, making Him the center of our thoughts, actions, and values, like the Tabernacle was the center of the Israelites' lives.

We should pitch our tent toward Christ, aligning ourselves with God's will and plan for the life that He has giving us. Making sacrifice to live for Him Clean and Holy as the Israelites made sacrifice to atone for their sins.

In essence, I understand this question not only to be a source of encouragement but as well as reflection on how one's life choices and priorities reflect our faith's commitment. It's about making the conscious decision to live in a way that honors and seek God and God alone and to make sacrifices for my own personal Tabernacle, carrying it with me through any wilderness that I may have wondered through, BUT knowing that even if for a moment my tent is pitched while I am in that wilderness, God's presence, provision and His love for me is with me and I am going to be alright. (Ora)



GARLIC BEANS WITH DILL

If you prefer a garlic flavor that is not quite as strong, remove the garlic clove just before adding the dill.

Ingredients

1 pound trimmed green beans

1 ½ tablespoons extra virgin olive oil

6 peeled and halved garlic cloves

1 tablespoon chopped fresh dill

1/4 teaspoon hot red pepper flakes (optional)

Directions

- 1. String the green beans and rinse.
- 2. Cut them into 1-inch lengths and steam for 10 to 15 minutes or until tender; drain.
- 3. Heat the olive oil in a skillet over very low heat.
- 4. Sauté the garlic in the hot oil for about 5 minutes or until tender; mash the garlic.
- 5. Stir in the dill, green beans, and red pepper flakes;
- 6. Cook, covered, over low heat for about 5 minutes.
- 7. Salt to taste and serve.

TWO INGREDIENT BISCUITS

Ingredients

- •2 cups White Lily Self-Rising Flour, not sifted
- •1 small carton (8 oz) whipping cream

Directions

- 1. Mix the two ingredients until it forms a doughy consistency
- 2. Knead until it forms a smooth dough
- 3. Roll out to about 1/4 inch thin
- 4. Cut out with cookie cutter, biscuit cutter or cup (the biscuit shrinks in width while cooking, so cut them wider than your preferred diameter) Place on a baking sheet and bake at 425° for 8-10 minutes

Served as a dip with pita bread or over grilled fish.

Ingredients

- •1 large bunch chopped cilantro
- •2 minced garlic cloves
- •¼ cup water
- ½ cup extra virgin olive oil
- •3 teaspoons fresh lime juice
- •¼ teaspoon cayenne pepper
- ¼ teaspoon coriander Celtic salt to taste

Directions

- 1. Combine the cilantro and garlic in a blender or food processor container.
- 2. Purée with the water and olive oil.
- 3. Add the lime juice, cayenne pepper, coriander, and salt; process briefly until well mixed.

OVEN BEEF STEW

Ingredients

- •1 pound uncooked round or chuck steak, cut into thin strips
- •6 small red potatoes, quartered
- ½ pound fresh trimmed green beans
- •6 peeled, sliced carrots or 1 pound miniature carrots
- •1 small chopped onion
- •1 14 ounce can low-sodium beef broth
- ½ cup whole wheat flour
- •½ teaspoon thyme
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- •2 teaspoons steak seasoning

Directions

- 1. Combine the steak, potatoes, green beans, carrots, and onion in a 9×13 -inch baking dish.
- 2. Combine the beef broth, flour, thyme, pepper, and steak seasoning in a medium bowl and whisk until smooth.
- 3. Pour the broth mixture evenly over the steak and vegetables.
- 4. Bake, tightly covered with foil, at 350 degrees for 40 minutes. Remove foil, stir well, and replace foil. Bake for 20 minutes longer.
