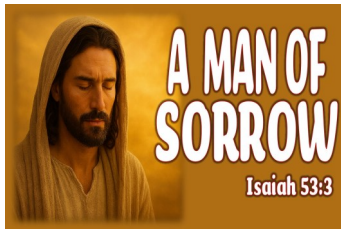

We talk about Jesus, a man of sorrow, acquainted with grief; but in John 15, around the 8th verse, we're going to talk about the fruit of the Spirit of God. He said (John 15:8), "This is to My Father's glory." How can we glorify God? Can you build something in this world great enough, or do any deed great enough to say, "This is worthy of God Almighty"? What can you do that you would present to God, that you say in yourself, "That's worthy"? But He said (John 15:8), "This is to My Father's glory," and what is it? That you bear much fruit. God is talking about this fruit, it's of your spirit, it's what comes through your soul.

Remember, Jesus told about the tree. When the owner of the vineyard came, He said this tree is not bearing fruit; I'll have to cut it down. The vine dresser, or the one that was taking care of that garden, we know Jesus does, said (Luke 13:8), "Let me dung around it, let me work with it for three years, let me just spend a little extra time with it," and that's what the owner of the vineyard wanted; He wants someone there who cares. He didn't want someone there to say to get rid of it; He wanted who He wanted, and He had who He had, and it was of His own nature, and that's what He's teaching us, and it was agreeable. But that fruit, you've got to bear that fruit of The New Principle of Life, and if you go on being the old man and you will not produce through your own soul the fruit that pleases God, then you can be cut off from God.

How do you bear the fruit? You have to be Born-again. I cannot impress upon you too much, don't say I can't live a Christian life; no one can live this, such a Christian life, without being Born-again. No one can. I can't. You can't. We don't have that New Principle of Life except through the Holy Spirit; it's nothing to our goodness as people, it's what we have, it's who loves us, who comes into us, who has begotten us.

You know, God impresses me, the eyes and the color you have; you don't say, well, I wanted this color and I said this or that; no, it's the genes, it's from whom you came, and God created the whole civilization and the whole creation of the world as we look around, so that in that eyesight of evidence we can see the work of God. And He said no, it isn't you that worked this; I worked this; you're of my genes, you're of my spirit, I did this, I brought that love with me into you, I begot you and the old man died, and I'm the Spirit that quickened you inside and raised the new creature inside of you that the world will not understand, and you could not understand until you were Born-again.

It is not a new year resolution Christian life. (Matthew 9:16) You don't put a new patch on an old garment; you don't take a wine skin that's already been filled up and stretched to capacity; you don't take the old man and try and say turn over a new leaf. (Matthew 9:17) You need a new wine skin; a newness in there; the old man died; where do you get the new man? From God

And that's why He said call no man Father but one, because you see we didn't get this from any earthly parentage; the only way you get this New Principle of Life is through Him who gives it; it is through Him who had to sacrifice. For God so loved the world, I'm talking about a sinful world, a world that He saw things that He hated, a world where He saw mankind; He couldn't see His image in there anymore. But He still loved the creature He created called man, and He's going to have man serve Him, and you know how He kept His word? He came, His own genes, His own flesh and blood, His own bone, His own person, walked this earth as man and was keeping the Father's word, praise God, not only just to show us that God can keep His word and that He's got a man that will, no, not just that. But that we can. We can. He come to give us life. He come to give us this New Principle of Life.

Now, love has a different meaning than the world who loves each other. You give, I give. You're nice to me, I'm nice to you. Oh, you hug me, I hug you. Sure, the world has that. But you have to go to the New Principle of what Love means. Now we're getting in (Galatians 5:22-23) the fruit of the Spirit: Love, Joy, Peace, Long-suffering, which means Patience, Kindness, Goodness, Gentleness. Have you ever seen the Gentleness of the Holy Spirit, the fruit? You know, you go to the tree; do you ever look at a fruit? You see if it's spotted, you see if it's doing alright, you see if it's tasty. When you see that fruit that doesn't have any blemish, how beautiful it is, how tasty, how pleasant to the eye. The garden in the beginning, He had all of these trees; it was so beautiful, pleasant to see. But that one of good and evil, you know the kind that says, oh, I love you today, you did something to me, so I hate you tomorrow, that's good and evil. God said don't eat it. It's still in the world. What spirit do you want to eat of? What spirit that produces fruit in you? (Joshua 24:15) Choose you this day whom you will serve. And that, off that other tree, the fallen humanity tree, you can be loving and beautiful one moment, and the next moment what can happen? Cursing, swearing, throwing things, angry without a cause. You can be angry and sin not at things that are wrong, but it won't stay on you and eat you up like a cancer, because He said don't let the sun go down on your anger; it's over by then.

Jesus got angry and whipped them, He told them what they were (John 2:13-17): sons of vipers, hypocrites. He had to talk to them. But He loved them. But do you know what they had to see? Where they were, and they had to see who they were from. In this passage it says (John 15:8), this is my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit. That means this New Principle of Life, fruitage of Love. Father sees you blessing them when they're cursing you, and that's God coming through you upon this earth, so that brings glory to the Father. When you have a child, you hold it in your arms, you see it walk across the floor; that is something that, you know, that God give you to produce. He made them male and female so they could produce. But you know, that's something of yours, something of your own body, of your own ability to bring forth life that God granted you, and it means something to you; it's glorious.

It said (John 15:8), this is my Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, and when He sees you walking with the New Principle of Life that come from Him, you are in His image. That's mine, He said, that's my child there. Not just Jesus, but He's Supreme. But it said that many sons can come to glory, can come to what's the glory, to that life. What is it Jesus said? (John 15:9) As a Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Do you see the pattern, the linkage? This love that's in me is from God, and the love that you'll find in you is from me; it's the same Love, it's the same Love. This Love that wasn't born in us coming through the wombs of flesh, I said this love that was not born in us, we had to be Born-again, and then we have that love. (John 15:9-11) Now remain in my love. Jesus said stay there; you don't come in and out. Remain in my love. If you obey my commands, you will remain in my love; do what I tell you, you'll be there, just as I have obeyed my Father's commands and remain in His love. He said that's where I live, is in my Father's house and in His Love, and you do the same. Because He said, I am Christ, and I'm going to give to you as the Father give to me, and it's going to flow, and it's going to go over the world, and no one can put out that flame. I have told you this.

Now listen, we were going to touch on Joy, the fruit of Joy. See, it's different than the world's fruit. The Love is different than the world's love. When people say, I don't understand you, it's because they haven't come into that, and we didn't understand either until we come into it, and the only way we come into it is through God who come into us. It's not our works; it's God's work. But you know what you have to do? You have to have faith in Jesus, and that is Salvation. Not in how many times you come go service, not in how many times you read the Bible, not in how many times you pray. But all those things you will do. But that isn't your Salvation. Your Salvation is Jesus. And faith, it's not if you can believe this will happen over here, that will happen.

But do you know, when they came to Jesus in faith, they believed that because of Him it could happen. The woman that pressed through said (Matthew 9:21), if I can touch His garment. One, the leper said (Matthew 8:2-3), if you will, I'll be healed. Jesus said, I will, and it was done. What is faith? It's not as you go and say, well, I'm going to believe this will happen, I've got power, I'm going to believe that. No, it's your belief in Jesus; that's your faith. And when you believe in Him, it's His faith. It's faith that God says you're obedient. Don't lose your faith and trust in Jesus. Hang on there. Keep your eye on Jesus. These other things you'll do because you have faith in Him. And He said (John 15:9), "Remain." You are to remain in His love. He said, "I remained in my Father's love."

You know, when He went to the cross, you don't hear this much. You heard He went to the cross for our sake. He went to the cross to save us. How many of you here said, yes, I've heard that, and I know that. Blessed be the name of Lord. But did you hear this a lot? He said, Arise. He said, "Arise, (John 14:31) I go to show the world that I love the Father." I go to show the world I love the Father. Come on, let's not forget those words. He said the Father's love is in me. Now, I remained in that Love. Now He said, my love is in you, and I want you to remain in my love. Arise. He was going to the cross. I will show the world that I love my Father. He was obedient even unto death. It said that the Greeks love wisdom; they thought that was foolish. Do you know how many times people think it's foolish what you do because you have faith in Jesus? Do you realize that? It's going to be foolish.

They said the cross was foolishness. But Paul said, praise God, (1 Corinthians 1:21) God chose that foolishness of preaching to save souls and save mankind. What they call foolishness is their Salvation. This Fruit of the Spirit, oh, I pray that God helps us today to see this New Principle of Life that come through Jesus. Maybe, if everyone says, well, I don't have it, but if you understand it, and if you want it, you can have it. It won't be your own work. Don't say you can't live it. We know that. If you haven't come into Christ, don't you see? Your faith in the life of Christ in you brings that life through you. Love, and I want you to hear this. (John 15:11) I've told you this so that my... has anyone got the open word? What is that next word? (JOY) What is it? (JOY) Jesus said that my what? (JOY) Joy.

You don't hear much about His Joy, do you? You hear a Man of Sorrows, suffering, cross, the blood. He said (John 15:11) that my Joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete. Jesus had this Joy. No, it wasn't a joy like the world has. Go to Penny Arcade. Maybe they're outdated. Well, I don't know. Maybe they've been more like a nickel, dime, or dollar. But anyway, they used to have Penny Arcades and have a lot of fun, and people relate fun with Joy. It's fun. Or they relate happiness. Ha, ha, ha, happiness.

There's a Joy in knowing Christ, that through the darkest hour and the darkest storms, that Peace and Joy is there. Now, the world don't have it. Jesus said (John 14:27), I give you my peace, the peace the world don't give you. You see, that comes with this new New Creature of Life that God gives us. There's a Peace, and there's a Joy. There's a Joy in knowing to whom you belong. Even when the trials come and the tribulations and the dark clouds, you have a Joy in your Father, you We'll have to go into it a little bit more at some other time, I feel. But this is a Joy that's from the New Principle of Life that doesn't come with a natural birth. And Jesus had it. And He said, I want this Love to be in you from me, like it was in me from the Father, and it's going right on to you. And I want the comman. I know you will remain in me if you do as I say. And He said that. That what? What was going on? What did He want? What fruitage did He want us to have? That my Joy, that in other words, you have this Joy. Not like the world gives you, children, but like God gives. Fruit of the Spirit that comes from a tree that you can't go out there and pluck the fruit off of. Bread from heaven that comes where you don't go to Super-Duper to buy it.

There's a New Principle of Life. And God does not ignore the created world He created. But He said (Matthew 6:28), Consider the Lily and how it grows. You know, Christians aren't out of it, as the world thinks, oh, they can't; nothing but Spirit, nothing but spirit. Wait a minute. There are historical events that have spiritual significance to the Christian, to spirit-minded people; they're just not things happen. Do you realize today how many things happen in your life that you lost? How many? How many things do you think happened in a day that don't even count to you? When the day is over, maybe you have a certain time in that day something counted. But how would you like to have life more abundantly, when everything in that day was precious? Jesus said (John 10:10), I come to give you life and life more abundantly. And everything. You're not disconnected with God for 10, 20 minutes and then you get connected again. Jesus said (John 16:32), my Father is with me always.

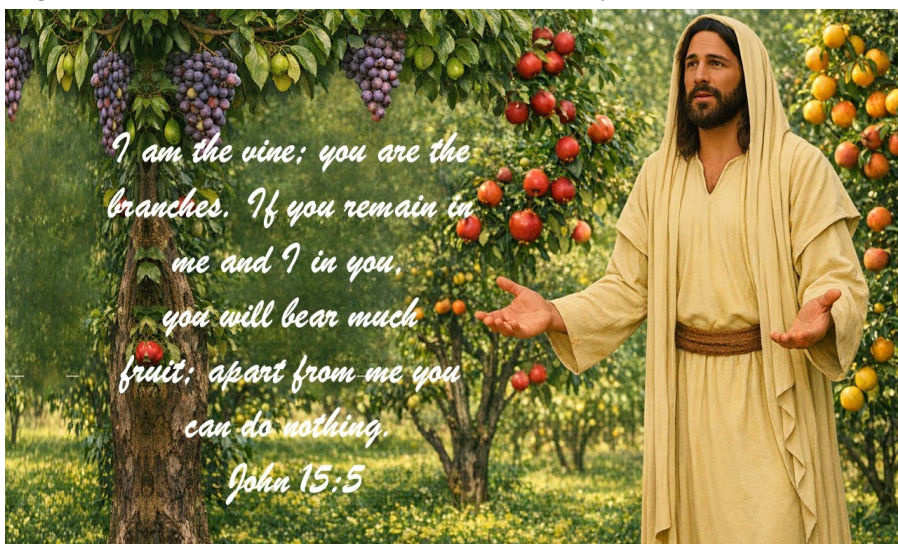
If we can just get a glimpse in these few moments, because it hasn't been long ministering the word, if you can grasp, if we all can grasp the New Principle of Life that Jesus brought. And it is not natural born Love, natural born Joy, natural born Goodness and Kindness and Gentleness. God has such a Gentleness, you wouldn't even begin to want to hurt anyone's feelings, not even that much. It's a Gentleness. And there's a Goodness with the Spirit, a Goodness that comes, that no, it's not the same as earthly born Goodness. If we can just grasp that today and carry it with us and say, God, I want to know more about the New Principle of Life that you brought, Jesus, that was telling us all along what Love really is.

We didn't have it through natural birth. We didn't even know what love was except through the Holy Ghost. Now, that's what the scripture says, and it is written and it cannot be wrong. What is this love?

Undying love. What is this love, that the

love that Jesus talks about? The Joy that Jesus talks about? That Fruit of the Spirit that Jesus talks about?

We've got to understand that it isn't the same as the natural birth love, joy, goodness. It's different. It's a spiritual given quality that comes through the Born-again soul. We praise the Lord.

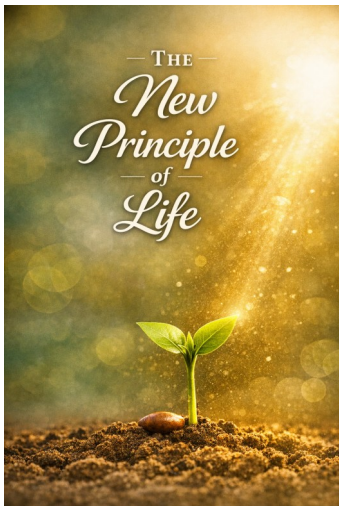

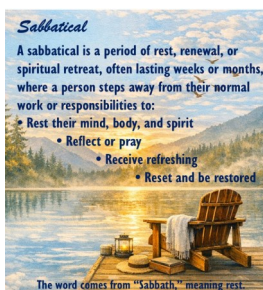
We also attended and partook of a Jewish Shabbat service on Friday evening. Upon entering the service, the Lord had me to say, “Shalom. Peace to you.”

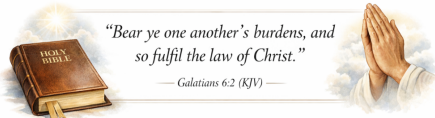

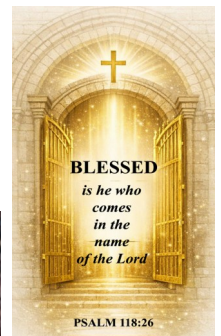

When we simplify what we eat, we quiet the noise of the flesh, and the spirit becomes clearer and more sensitive to God. Daniel fasted for understanding, wisdom, and direction, and God responded with clarity and help. This fast opens our hearts to receive from God. It's like turning down the world's volume so we can hear the whisper of the Holy Spirit.

## DANIEL'S GARDEN BOWL

### Ingredients

- Chopped cucumbers
- Cherry tomatoes
- Sliced red onion
- Fresh parsley
- Cooked lentils
- Olive oil
- Lemon juice
- Pinch of salt & pepper

### Directions

1. Combine vegetables and lentils in a bowl.
2. Drizzle with olive oil and lemon juice.
3. Season lightly and toss.
4. Serve chilled or room temperature.

## LENTIL & BARLEY STEW

### Ingredients

- Cooked lentils
- Cooked barley
- Carrots
- Onion
- Garlic
- Celery
- Olive oil
- Water or vegetable broth
- Pinch of salt

### Directions

1. Sauté onion, celery, and garlic.
2. Add carrots, lentils, barley, and broth.
3. Simmer 15–20 minutes.
4. Serve warm



## SIMPLE CHICKPEA SALAD

### Ingredients

- Chickpeas
- Cucumbers
- Tomatoes
- Fresh herbs
- Olive oil
- Lemon juice
- Salt & pepper

### Directions

1. Mix chickpeas and vegetables.
2. Add herbs, olive oil, and lemon juice.
3. Toss and enjoy.

## ANCIENT GRAIN BREAKFAST BOWL

### Ingredients

- Cooked oats, barley, or millet
- Sliced figs or dates
- Nuts or seeds
- Warm water or unsweetened almond milk

### Directions

1. Warm the grains.
2. Add fruit and nuts.
3. Splash with warm liquid.
4. Serve as a simple, nourishing breakfast.

## ROASTED VEGETABLE MEDLEY

### Ingredients

- Chopped zucchini
- Chopped carrots
- Chopped sweet potatoes
- Red bell pepper slices
- Olive oil
- Pinch of salt & pepper
- Dried thyme or rosemary



### Directions

1. Toss vegetables with olive oil and seasonings.
2. Spread on a baking sheet.
3. Roast at 400°F for 20–25 minutes until tender.
4. Serve warm as a simple, nourishing meal.

## CUCUMBER & HERB WATER

### Ingredients

- Water
- Cucumber slices
- Fresh mint or basil

### Directions

1. Add cucumber and herbs to water.
2. Chill 1–2 hours.
3. Serve cold.



## WARM LENTIL & WALNUT BOWL

### Ingredients

- 1 cup cooked lentils
- A handful of chopped walnuts
- Sautéed spinach or kale
- Olive oil
- Pinch of salt
- Squeeze of lemon



### Directions

1. Warm the lentils in a skillet with a drizzle of olive oil.
2. Add spinach or kale until wilted.
3. Stir in chopped walnuts.
4. Finish with a light squeeze of lemon.
5. Serve warm.

## LEMON & MINT WATER

### Ingredients

- Lemon slices
- Fresh mint
- Water

### Directions

1. Add lemon and mint to a pitcher of water.
2. Chill 1 hour.
3. Serve cold.

# THURSDAY NIGHT - BIBLE STUDY RECAP

## THE NEW PRINCIPLE OF LIFE – JOY, PART 1

Highlights taken from The Lord in Pastor Jo Vah's powerful teaching,

**Joy** is not a fleeting emotion but the living reality of Christ within us — a New Principle of Life that is given, not manufactured. Joy is born when the old nature dies and the born-again life takes root; it is the fruit of the Spirit, not the product of human striving. “You don't hear much about His Joy, do you? Jesus said, (John 15:11) that my Joy, may be in you And that your joy may be complete.” And we should remember that, “There's a Joy in knowing Christ. That; through the darkest hour and the darkest storms, that Peace and Joy, is there.”

**Joy** is the visible evidence that Christ's life is flowing through us. It is the same love the Father poured into Jesus and that Jesus pours into us; it is the life that produces gentleness, goodness, peace, and endurance. This joy strengthens and steadies us — not by removing trials, but by changing how we stand in them, when the world chases temporary pleasure, we are reminded that bearing this fruit requires union with Christ.

Remaining in His love is not a passive suggestion but the soil in which joy grows. Obedience, faith, and dependence are the daily practices that keep us connected to the Vine so the Spirit can do His work. The fruit people see in us — a quiet patience, a steady kindness, a goodness that refuses to be shaken — is not our achievement but God's work made visible in us.

Practically, this means we are invited to receive the New Principle of Life by faith and to live from that received life. When trials come, we can proclaim the joy of the Lord as our strength and choose to look for the evidences of Christ at work: a gentle reply where anger might have flared, a patient presence where impatience would have ruled, a sacrificial kindness when convenience called. These are the marks of a life transformed.

Pastor JoVah's message is both comforting and challenging. Comforting because the joy Jesus gives is real and sustaining; challenging because it calls us to a deeper dependence on Him rather than on our own efforts. The invitation is simple and profound: remain in Christ, let His life flow through us, and allow that New Principle of Life to bear its fruit so others may see Jesus in us.

## THE POWER OF THE **BLOOD**

We're reminded this Easter that everything we celebrate, salvation, forgiveness, new life, and victory, flows from the power of the Blood of JESUS. In Scripture, Blood represents life, and GOD uses Blood as the means of cleansing, covenant, and redemption. The cross is where all of these truths come together.

The Blood That Atones and Redeems From the beginning, GOD established that "it is the Blood that makes atonement" (Leviticus 17:11). JESUS fulfilled this perfectly. The Blood That Cleanses and Transforms The Blood doesn't just cover sin; it cleanses it. "The Blood of JESUS cleanses us from all sin." (1 John 1:7) This cleansing reaches the heart, the conscience, and the inner life. It gives us the power to walk in newness.

The Blood That Gives Victory Revelation 12:11 declares that believers "overcame him by the Blood of the Lamb and the word of their testimony." The Blood is our spiritual covering, protection, and our victory over the enemy.

The Blood That Seals the New Covenant At the Last Supper, JESUS said, "This is My Blood of the covenant." His Blood opened the way for us to have relationship with GOD, and the promise of eternal life.

The Blood That Speaks On this Resurrection SONday, we pause to remember the precious Blood that was shed for us. On the cross, JESUS poured out His life so that we could receive ours back. His Blood speaks a better word; one of mercy, forgiveness, and hope.

The Blood says, "You are redeemed."

The Blood says, "You are forgiven."

The Blood says, "You are covered."

The Blood says, "You are Mine."

On Good Friday, the Blood was shed.

On Saturday, the Blood was working.

On Sunday morning, the Blood was vindicated when JESUS rose with all power in His hands.

The resurrection is GOD's eternal "Yes" to the sacrifice of His Son. It is the proof that the Blood has power—power to save, power to cleanse, power to restore, and power to give new life.

As we celebrate Easter on today, may we stand in the victory of the Lamb, remembering that His Blood still speaks, still saves, and still sets free.
