




We're going to be in Matthew 26, the key verse in 39. It was a time of great sorrow for the Lord; He had times of tiredness, time of taking our infirmities upon Him, time of taking sicknesses, and illnesses upon Himself. Verse 38 says; *then saith He unto them, My Soul is exceeding sorrowful even unto death, tarry ye here, and watch with Me.* You know the Lord said He was in exceeding sorrow, it wasn't just a little unhappiness, because the word tells us that, He was a man of sorrow who walked with many sorrows. So, when He said He was exceeding sorrow, even unto death that's how sorrowful He was, it was quite a drastic time in His life. The scripture doesn't say here that He knelt down, it said He felled on His face and prayed; saying; *Oh, My Father, if it be possible...let this cup pass from Me. Nevertheless, not as I will but as Thou will.* The Lord has a will and I have a need to rest in it, nest in it, fully be blessed in it, following my Father's will. Now, this was a bitter cup time.

I want you to take note of the word; nevertheless, that's exactly what He was not taking, He was not taking the less portion than what His Father wanted. He said, *if it be possible, let this cup pass from me, nevertheless, not as I will but as Thou will.* Father always willed that which was greater for man, even when it took sorrow, pain and death. He never let the man live in the lesser place because the greater place required suffering or sorrow, or the bitter cup. If you and I can really see this in our soul and realize it; saying the Lord has a will, and I have a need, you will see that the need of Christ was more than having a bitter cup removed, it was a need in Him more demanding in His Soul then being released from pain or sorrow.

The Lord has a will, and I have a need to follow that will, to rest in it, and nest in it. You know when the birds have a nest, you see them building that nest, then you know it's time for those eggs and life comes forth. I have a need to nest in it and be fully blessed in it. The Lord said *if I be lifted up, I'll draw all men unto me.* Father had a will, Jesus had that need to follow that will, that was greater than that pain of the cross that would send Him away. The need that God said *I would that You have the crown*, the need of the Father's will for Him, was greater.

The Lord has a will, and I have a need to please my God.



Jesus said at one time *“My meat is to do the will of my Father.”* His disciples said; does He have meat that we don't know of? Did He get something to eat here? Because when they came to Him and they were there to get food, when they brought it to Him, He wanted no physical food. They said, “Has He had something to eat already? He said, *“My meat is to do the will of my Father.”*

That's my substance, that is what keeps me going. That's the deep things that I digest and that I chew on day and night. The Lord has a will, and I have a need to be in that will of God. John 17:24. We find the Lord again, was in prayer, and He said, *“Thy will be done.”* In that verse you'll find that, the Lord had a will and His will was that you and I be with Him in His Glory. Father had a will, the Spirit for that Son of man. The Spirit's will is greater than the flesh's will and Jesus had a need to follow His Father's will no matter where it put Him. In the garden's prayer He said, *“I will, that they be with me and behold My glory.”* No matter what it may take, in our lives, God has given us the power to meet the need and we need to fulfill His will. Matthew 3:15, we find the baptism time was a fulfillment of the Spirit's will, John is saying; I am here to witness this and I don't really know Him myself, but what my God tells me that's the one I see, the Spirit in the form of a dove descend and stay on Him, he said: I'll know that is the Messiah, The Lamb of God. John said, I am to be a witness to this, I'm not the Christ but I've been chosen out a voice crying in the wilderness; prepare ye the way of the Lord, and he said God would reveal to him how he would know Him. And when that day came, John the Baptist said, “Behold the lamb of God”. Then he said to the great Christ, I am not worthy to unlatch your shoes. No one have any authority of baptism rights over you, that is what he meant. But Jesus was following a need in Him, to fulfill God's will. Jesus said, *“to fulfill all righteousness”* let it be. There was a need for Him to go down into the water and to come up, there was a need He had to fulfill something that His Father wanted fulfilled. He had a need and He did what He had to do.

We find in Mark 8:33 one of the times that Jesus rebuked satan; the adversary was there to use Peter's body, blind the disciples mind, and the adversary wanted his will to be done, that Christ would not go upon the cross and that the blood of God would not be shed on earth for you and I. We find that satan has a will that he wants to fulfill something, in this world. Jesus said in that scripture, when He rebuked Peter, He said, *“you savor the things that be of man, and not God”*. in other words, our need is to fulfill what God wants us to do. Too many times man finds his day full of fulfilling what he wants to do or what someone else wants him to do, when the scripture tells us; do all things unto the Lord. Now you might think you can do that in yourself, but I have found that it takes a power from within; to do all things unto the Lord. TV taping is unto the Lord, production time is unto the Lord, eating and fixing a meal is unto the Lord, Prayer; of course is unto the Lord, and assembling together is unto the Lord. Not for others but we do it for God, we do it and we know that God does it for our sakes. It's no more than what we should do. We should come to every service and when God does bring someone in, and of course the Shepherd of the flock is always there and shouldn't be disregarded, but when He brings someone else in then we should go, because the Lord has brought someone in to tell us something. Not saying; Oh, did you hear who is coming this one or that one, well, we know this one, tell them to come for the Lord. The Lord wants us to hear it. The Lord has sent His special messenger, He wants us to be together.

The Lord has a will, and I have a need to be in the will of the Lord, to rest in it. I have peace in the valley with God, Why? because God wanted me to go, and God sent me. When you do all things unto the Lord, you won't get under the automobile or crawl under a car or lift the hood up, or begin to use your skills as a mechanic, without doing it unto the Lord. The Lord wants the car to run, the Lord wants you to have transportation to bring others here, the Lord want my family to be able to go, for your sake. All things we do should be unto the Lord, and it takes a lot of Holy Ghost living, from within to fulfill that, but God in our soul makes a way. We do fulfill His will, we do it by the power of the Holy Son within us. Jesus said *He did nothing but what He saw the father do*. I know many will say, well that was Christ; and I would say yes and that's why we should follow Him. We have received



the power to become Sons of God, not just servants, though we serve, and are servants in our youth, and we will always serve God. Thank you God, there is SONship in God.





MAPLE GLAZED SALMON

Ingredients

- 4 (4-6 ounce) salmon fillets
- 1 clove garlic, finely chopped or 1 cube frozen garlic
- $\frac{1}{3}$ cup maple syrup
- 3 tablespoons olive oil
- 2 tablespoons soy sauce
- 2 tablespoons Dijon mustard
- 1 tablespoon yellow mustard

Directions

1. Preheat oven to 500°
2. Arrange salmon fillets on a baking sheet. Pat dry and sprinkle with salt and black pepper.
3. In a small bowl, combine garlic, maple syrup, olive oil, soy sauce, Dijon mustard, and yellow mustard
4. Pour three quarters of dressing over fish, and bake for approximately 15 minutes, uncovered.
5. Remove from oven and immediately brush with remaining dressing.

BAKED BEETS

Ingredients

- Beets
- Low-fat sour cream
- Fresh lime juice

Directions

1. Wash unpeeled whole beets and remove their tops.
2. Arrange them on a baking sheet and bake at 350 degrees, uncovered, for 1 hour.
3. Let cool slightly then slip off the skins.
4. Mash the pulp and serve with low-fat sour cream.
5. Squeeze a bit of fresh lime juice over the beets just before serving.

MILK AND HONEY BREAD


Ingredients

- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup honey
- 1 cup skim milk
- 3 tablespoons extra virgin olive oil
- $1\frac{1}{2}$ cups whole wheat flour
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup sugar (or $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon liquid Stevia)
- 1 tablespoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon Celtic salt
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup chopped pecans
- 1 egg, beaten

Directions

1. Combine the honey and milk in a medium saucepan over medium heat and cook, stirring constantly, until honey dissolves.
2. Stir in the olive oil. Remove from heat and let cool.
3. Sift the flour, sugar, baking powder, and salt into a large mixing bowl.
4. Add the pecans and toss to coat.
5. Whisk the egg into the cooled milk mixture.
6. Add the egg mixture to the flour mixture. Beat just until blended.
7. Pour into a lightly greased and floured loaf pan and smooth the top.
8. Bake at 350 degrees for 65 to 75 minutes or until a wooden pick inserted in the center comes out clean. Cool in the pan on a wire rack for about 10 minutes. Remove from pan and cool completely on the rack.

CHILLED STRAWBERRY SOUP

Ingredients

- 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ cups sliced fresh strawberries
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup sour cream
- $\frac{3}{4}$ cup heavy cream
- 2 tablespoons orange juice
- 2 tablespoons honey
- 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoons finely chopped fresh mint leaves fresh strawberry slices, kiwifruit slices, or mint sprigs

Directions

1. Combine the 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ cups strawberries, sour cream, heavy cream, orange juice, and honey in a blender; process until smooth.
2. Stir in the chopped mint.
3. Taste for sweetness; if necessary, add more honey.
4. Refrigerate, covered, until well chilled. Ladle into chilled soup bowls. Garnish with strawberry slices, kiwifruit slices, or mint sprigs and serve.





MY TESTIMONY

On the morning of March 27th, I was on my way to work, the sun was rising in the east as I traveled east on Main St. to York Rd., onto Broad St. I moved into the turn lane and waited for the oncoming traffic to clear. It was clear so I proceeded onto York Rd. The front portion of my car had made it onto York Rd., suddenly I felt an impact, my car jolted; and I saw a white vehicle pass by quite rapidly along my right side. My face jammed into a huge white balloon like substance (airbag) that hit my nose quite painfully and I instantly felt the blood that came along with the impact. I felt the same impact on my chest. Another airbag was released on my left side. I was stunned, I sat there not knowing what to do, I smelled fire as I continued to sit there unable to move trying to grasp all that had just happened.

There were three men came and stood by my car, one of the men asked me if I was okay but I could not respond. One was on his cell phone making hand gestures. When I saw his phone, I immediately heard; call the Lord's house. I didn't even have to look for my phone it was right there by my side. I know that was Jesus! I called the Lord's house and left a message. I had some concerns that I did not have the opportunity to speak to Doris directly, so I asked the Lord to let her know what was going on and where I was AND He did!

Someone approached me at the door and spoke to me but I still could not respond. He opened the car door for me and asked me if I could get out. As I unlocked my seat belt trying to get out, my legs felt very unsteady and shaky. He helped me get out of the car as I held onto his arm, he slowly walked me to the ambulance as I could not keep up with him at his pace. As I struggled to get into the ambulance, I thanked the Lord, He was encouraging me, helping me to get focused. I began to realize more of what happened, what was going on.

The medic help me sit on the stretcher and told me he'd be right back. I used my phone to make a quick call to work, informing them of my situation. When the medic returned, he started asking me questions, and I was able answer. Both medics thought it would be in my best interest to go to the hospital and so I did.

As we traveled to the hospital, the Lord kept me calm and quiet and I was thanking Him for helping me. My blood pressure and heart rate were very high, but feeling the Lord's presence and His love kept me calm. Jesus reminded me of the time when I broke the bones in my ankle and leg, He told me that time, so sweet, gentle, and loving, He said to me; "We will get through this," and we did.



When we arrived at the hospital, I was embarrassed but quite humbled. A huge medical team waited for my arrival. One of the nurses said, "well you look well considering you had the roof top ripped from your car." I replied, no that was not me, the response was we're here take care of you. I thank the Lord that He blessed and I was treated with respect and dignity in the removal of my clothing. I knew that Jesus was with me through it all. The hospital staff kept me informed of all that they were doing. IV insertion for any meds; thank you Jesus no meds were needed. X-rays, blood draws, vitals, EKG, and CT scan were all negative, and last of all a short term room for my stay. I did not want a room, but a temporary room would be fine. As soon as I was in my room, the Lord sent me company, just in time!! Jehovah God is an Awesome God. I was released from the hospital with good report, no worries no concern all was well, Thank you Jesus.

I'm so grateful to Him for all that He did throughout the day. I was thankful that He had His people to search, and rescue and be a help. God told me, His troops worked and He had them on the job. I said troops like the army! Yes the army. We are in the Lord's army, He is our commander in chief and He reigns in all and overall for He is the King of Kings and Lord of Lords! He reigns forever! *2 Timothy 2, Join with me in suffering, like a good soldier of Christ Jesus.*

Ephesians 6:11-18, Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. ¹² For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. ¹³ Therefore put on the full armor of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground, and after you have done everything, to stand. ¹⁴ Stand firm then, with the belt of truth buckled around your waist, with the breastplate of righteousness in place, ¹⁵ and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace. ¹⁶ In addition to all this, take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming arrows of the evil one. ¹⁷ Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. ¹⁸ And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert, always keep on praying for God's people.




